The Susquehanna County Farm Bureau is offering a Summer Farm Tour on August 26, 2010.

Laser Midstream Company sent a Letter of Notification to the Township to satisfy Acts 14, 67 and 127. A map was attached to the notification.

DTE Energy Pipeline is proposing a pipeline. A map was enclosed with the correspondence. It is called the Bluestone Gathering System. The company will be contacting property owners but are contacting government officials first.

Dan attended the COG meeting. He had a copy of the minutes from the previous month. One sewer permit has been applied for in Franklin Township by Michele & Duane Heeman. It is a repair permit.

Dan attended the NTC Meeting on July 15. Dan was given a check for \$4274. NTC returned money from the zoning grant. The next meeting is in October. Dan had a copy of the NTC Treasurer's Report.

New business – Carolyn Pratt, Leif Winter and Cathy Chiarella would like to attend an auditors training. Dan made motion for the Township to pay for the registration and mileage to attend the training. Mark seconded the motion. The motion passed with 3 yes votes.
