## FREEZING ACT 205 PENSION PLAN BENEFITS AND PARTICIPATION

WHEREAS the pension plan was initially established on January 1, 2005, and

WHEREAS the plan granted benefits to 3 full-time employees retroactive to their first eligibility date, and

WHEREAS of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009, the pension plan had a remaining liability of \$126,338, and

**WHEREAS** the pension plan received a Distress Level 2 rating from the Pennsylvania Public Employee Retirement Commission in 2010, and

**WHEREAS** adding additional benefits and employees to the pension plan would create a perpetual and ever increasing financial burden to the Township and it's residents,

**IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that as of December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2010, no new employees will enter into or participate in the pension plan, and

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that no additional benefits will be earned under the pension plan for existing employees after December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2010.
